

WAREHOUSING & LOGISTICS



Warehousing has become one of the highest growth career opportunities in the Bay Area with thousands of projected job openings in the next decade.

The ATLAS Basic Warehousing and Logistics training program will prepare you for employment in a warehouse or shipping facility making from \$10 to \$13 an hour, often with benefits.

This ATLAS training will last six weeks and provide an introduction to warehouse technology, forklift operation, and basic warehousing processes and procedures.

TRAINING CONTENT:

- Introduction to basic warehouse operations and systems
- Warehouse technology-GIS and Radio Frequency ID systems
- Forklift Operation and Certification
- Physical conditioning and Injury Prevention
- Math and English for the Warehouse Workplace
- Vocational counseling, job readiness, and Placement into employment

TRAINING REQUIREMENTS:

- Basic Math and English Skills
- The ability to be on time
- A willingness to work
- The ability to be in training from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday through Thursday, for six weeks
- The ability to pass a drug screening if required

EMPLOYMENT:

ATLAS was designed with the input of regional warehousing employers, many of whom are also employers of ATLAS Warehousing Graduates. ATLAS Vocational Counselors and Account Specialists will work with you to develop an opportunity with a regional warehousing or shipping facility.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I need a High School Diploma?

No—ATLAS Warehouse training is designed for anyone with sixth grade math and English Skills

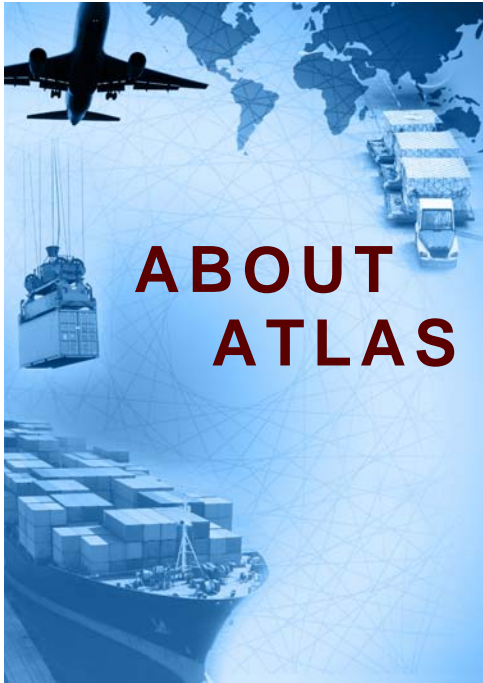
What if I don't have strong Math and English Skills
